*****SHOOT ONE DISCIPLINE OR BOTH ---- YOUR CHOICE*****

PURPOSE: To have a fun match that will end the indoor season. To raise money to help support the junior shooters in our area and to introduce Senior rifle shooters to the A-36 targets. Junior shooters are welcome!

POTLUCK LUNCH: It will be a time to meet friends and finish up the season.

RULES: NRA Smallbore rifle and pistol rules will govern. Smallbore rifle rule 3.2 and pistol rule 3.4. Rifle is any-sight 3-position half course match. This means the A-36 target will be used.

ELIGIBILITY: Any shooter who has competed in the Spokesman-Review postal league in the past.

ENTRIES: Entries will be on a first come first served basis.

FEES: Across the board entries for all the matches will be \$10.00. Rifle only will be \$5.00. Pistol only will also be \$5.00. All funds after expenses will go towards Junior shooting programs in the area.

CHALLENGE FEES: Please bring all challenges to the attention of the Match Director, for clarification.

*****SQUADDING: The first RIFLE relay will be at 9 A.M.. The second RIFLE relay will follow at 10:30 A.M. or when the first relay is complete. A quick meeting of the Association will begin when the second relay is complete. The first relay for PISTOL will begin promptly after the meeting. The second PISTOL relay will begin after the 1st if necessary.

SCORING: Scoring will be done by the available personnel. All scoring questions will be answered by the range officer in charge. All scores are final.

CLASSIFICATION: Your current NRA classification will be used. Unclassified shooters may be classed using this years Spokesman-Review scores.

AWARDS: This will be a White Elephant award system. Every shooter entering can bring a prize with a value of no more than \$5.00. One prize per discipline being shot, if you expect to receive a prize in return. All prizes will be placed on a table, Match winner picks first moving to the first place winner in the next class until last shooter picks. Rifle prizes will be awarded at or around NOON. Pistol will be awarded after the last relay finishes. All prizes left will become the possession of the IER&PA and will be used at next years Match. Winners in each class and discipline will have their name engraved on a perpetual trophy to be viewed at the range.

MATCH SCHEDULE: RIFLE MATCH # 1 20 shots prone (1 minute per shot)
2 20 shots offhand (1.5 minutes per shot)
3 20 shots kneeling (1 minute per shot)
4 Aggregate of matches 1, 2, and 3
SHORT MEETING WILL FOLLOW THE RIFLE MATCHES -- ALL WELCOME
PISTOL MATCH # 5 20 shots slow fire
6 30 shots national match course
7 20 shots timed fire
8 20 shots rapid fire
9 Aggregate of matches 5, 6, 7, and 8

RANGE DIRECTIONS: From the North, turn right at the end of 5th following signs to Priest River, go about 3 long blocks to traffic light at Dub's Drive Inn on the left (cross road is Boyer Ave.), go one block, turn right on Lake St., go about 4 blocks. Dark Grey bldg. on edge of City Park across from City Hall. From the South, follow road through town taking a left at the third stop light which is 5th, a one way street. Follow directions for the folks from the North.
