your shooting and score your target. A score of 60 or better is all you need. Bring your qualification card to the next Range Committee meeting and we can see that it's done.

In addition to the excitement on Range 1, hunter sight-in will be beginning soon. If you have a little time to man a spotting scope and help our friends get sighted-in while staying safe on Range 2, it would be a lot of help to the Range staff. In addition to being great opportunity to have some fun with people you don't always see and to promote the club.

There are lots of opportunities to be involved in your club and I encourage you to take advantage of them. From competition, instruction, work parties, hunter sight-in, or committee involvement, there are many ways to be included and take part.
