We finished our year of classes with a full four weekends of training. On 24-25 November we had 8 students for Basic Rifle. Martin Morehouse, Glenn Stinson, and Robert Rye presented the lessons for this class.

Our team of Pam Duncan and Cindy Murdock conducted the next class, First Steps Shotgun on 1 December. They awarded certificates to 8 new shotgun shooters.

7 students completed the Basic Pistol Class on 15 – 16 December, learning safety and new skills. Phil Murray, Paul Smith, and David Kizhnerman conducted the classroom and range instruction.

On the same weekend, 15 December, 4 students completed our last Home Firearms Safety class of the year. Bill Bentler and Joe Pierson worked together to introduce their students to safe firearms handling.

For 2012, we provided basic firearms instruction to 96 Shotgun students, 91 Pistol students, 118 Home Firearms Safety students, and 90 Rifle students. We also presented 2 Instructor Training classes and supported the only NRA Training Counselor workshop in the Northwest for the year.
