Range one baffles and projects

The range #1 baffles project has taken much more time, money and effort than any one envisioned. During the construction process a number of additional problems were unveiled. Safety is job number one and the range will not be opened until the board is satisfied the range construction is completed and safe. The contractor has done a great job and the board is pleased with the quality of work. As of the writing of this newsletter the following work is yet to be completed. The old road way from the one hundred yard line up to the upper level needs to be removed as this is now an impact area. The water line to shotgun needs to be replaced as it is located in the roadway. The ground water drainage from range #2 onto range #1 needs to be completed. A 7th row of baffles is going to be constructed. This last row of baffles along with raising the shooting platform will allow us to shoot safely from the prone position.

Baffle's part two

The board has reviewed range #2 for needed updates and repairs and has determined that work is needed there. When range #1 construction is signed off by Snohomish County building department, we are going to attend to the problems on Range 2. This has been a

painful process for everyone involved. We are nearing the end of range #1 construction and thank all of you for your continued patience and understanding. We should not need to go through this again for another 40 years.
